2:15 pm – In the heart of the secret valleys of Colombé le Sec, where the silhouette of Charles de Gaulle seems to watch over the landscape, the Gothic columns of the Clairvaux monks' cellar reveal an ancestral winemaking tradition that began in 1194. Since then, the Calon-Egger family has continued the art of winemaking, transforming grape bunches into exceptional champagne that has spanned the centuries.

4:15 pm - Located in Bar-sur-Seine, the Commanderie d'Avalleur is a gem from the Templar era, rich with nearly 900 years of history. Given to the Order of the Temple before 1142, this unique commandery is one of the few French ensembles from that period that has stood the test of time. With its chapel, main building, and barns, Avalleur invites you on a journey through time.
